Criteria for the Scoresby Family Psychology Scholarship

1. The **Scoresby Family Psychology Scholarship** is an award based on *merit* and *achievement*—particularly in psychology, not on need.
2. This scholarship is available only to students with a cumulative Maricopa Community College District GPA of **3.25 and above**. The student's GPA in psychology courses will also be considered. Students should attach an unofficial copy of their transcript(s) to their application.
3. Students *must* be current MCC students and have *completed* at least 20 (twenty) semester hours at MCC including a **minimum** of 6 (six) hours of Psychology Department courses.
4. Participation in extra-curricular activities and community service are considered highly desirable.
5. The number of withdrawals on a student's transcript will be considered.
6. The applicant will submit a completed application, essays, and unofficial transcript to the Psychology Department **before 12:00 noon on Friday, November 13, 2009**.
7. The Department will not hold interviews with those students nominated for the scholarship.
8. Selection of the award will be by secret ballot.
9. The Psychology Department reserves the right to not award a scholarship.
