**At least 2 semesters prior to transfer:**

- Apply for admission to the University
- Take the SAC or ACT and obtain the appropriate score required.
- Send your SAT or ACT scores to ASU
- Complete 7 of the 10 skills courses:  
CIS105, MAT212, MAT217 or MAT218, ENG101, ENG102, ECN211, ECN212.
- Send your transcripts to ASU

**At least 1 semester prior to transfer:**

- Be enrolled in any of the 10 skill courses not yet completed.
- Apply for admission to the ASU W.P. Carey Professional program during the enrollment period.
- Arrange for skill course grades to faxed to ASU when assigned.
