




Select "Start Now" under the fourth option - "Non-Credit"




If you have a Maricopa Email/SID, select "Yes" and sign in with your MEID and password, then skip to slide 6. If not select "No" and proceed to slide 3.

If you hit "No" in the previous step and you do not have an MEID fill out the form.








Time to Cross Some T's and Dot Some I's

Verify Your ID

- You have the option to skip this step, however it is suggested you complete this ASAP. If you do not complete this step, you will have to verify your ID in person before you can start classes
- To verify your ID, you can either submit a picture of a driver's license or ID card using your smart phone, or a scanned picture saved to your computer.
- The application can take up to 10 minutes, so don't worry if it seems like it is taking a long time to process.



- Fill out your ID information
- If you are not using a driver's license, there is a list of acceptable forms of ID you can use.
- You can upload a picture from your phone or from your computer. The file must be either a jpeg, jpg, pdf, or png.




